KUDOS TO OUR PRIMARY VOTERS

On Tuesday, September 14th, the Monroe County Conservative Party had a Primary Election for three open positions in Monroe County Court. We had previously endorsed Henrietta Town Judge Jim Piampiano, Irondequoit Town Judge Vince Dinolfo and East Rochester Town Judge Vicki Argento. They have been elected Judges for a combined total of 21 years. They have been endorsed by the Conservative Party a combined total of 8 times. Our three excellent Judges share our Conservative values. They are "firm and fair" Judges.

Liberal Democrat Kelly Wolford forced a Conservative Primary. She took the endorsement of the misnamed Working Families Party (W.F.P.) which is closely associated with the criminal enterprise know as ACORN. She has been an appointed Judge for three months. She was appointed by Governor Paterson for obvious partisan political reasons. (Andy Moore's outrageous appeal and/or being an enrolled Democrat, etc.) Attorneys who have appeared before her in Family Court in the last 3 months describe her as "unprepared", "not knowledgeable of the law", "weak", and "unfair".

Ms. Wolford ran an arrogant, aggressive and expensive Conservative Primary Campaign. She did extensive T.V. ads. (Monday Night Football, etc.) Ms. Wolford did 4 slick colorful mailings to all of the enrolled Conservatives. She did extensive billboards. Ms. Wolford and her husband visited over 2,000 Conservative homes. They attempted to contact every Conservative by phone. The Wolfords' concentrated on the Conservative Primary and ignored the Independence Primary.

Therefore, she unexpectedly lost that Primary even though she was the "official" endorsed Independence candidate.

Ms. Wolford ran a very dishonest and deceptive Conservative Primary Campaign. Enrolled Conservatives have told us that some of her petition passers said she was endorsed by the Conservative Party. Ms. Wolford alleged extensively in a mailing that a Conservative Party member, Hank Love, strongly supported her. The Board of Elections (Democratic and Republican Commissioners) stated in a letter that there has never been an enrolled Conservative named Hank Love or a Conservative of a similar name registered in Monroe County. She incorrectly misstated and belittled the duties of her opponents in Town Court. She claimed a high rating from a screening committee (Governor's 4th Department Judicial Screening Committee) where she was the only primary candidate interviewed. Her entire campaign was based on the theme: "Return Judge Wolford to County Court." However, she has never presided over a single case in County Court. How can she return to a place where she has never been? It is troubling that a judicial candidate could run such a dishonest and deceptive campaign!

The election results were overwhelming! This was thanks to the hard work of our 37 "pull captains" who contacted 1,371 Conservative "pull people". One Judge defeated Ms. Wolford 1,232 to 383. She only received 9% of the total vote. There was an 18% Conservative primary voter turnout, the highest turnout of any political party. What a great victory for our three Judges, for the

Monroe County community, and for the Monroe County Conservative Party. The Primary Conservative voters saw through the money, the effort, and the fraud. They confirmed that the Monroe County Conservative Party is a Party of loyalty and of conservative principles. Congratulations to our Conservative Primary voters!

CITY HALL HELPS TARGET MAGGIE

In July, Monroe County appropriately terminated a lucrative annual 14 million dollar contract with the Center for Disability Rights. (CDR). In retaliation, CDR's chief operating officer, Chris Hilderbrant, hired a sleazy, homeless investigator to "dig up dirt" on Monroe County Executive Maggie Brooks. There is no reason to look for damaging information unless it is going to be used in an inappropriate way. Was Maggie going to be blackmailed, threatened, or coerced? She clearly was the intended victim.

When Mr. Hilderbrant needed a reference regarding his "dirt digger" he contacted Mayor Duffy's top aide Darryl Porter. Mr. Porter vouched for her investigative skills. He gave the dirt digger a favorable character reference. Hilderbrant then called Mr. Duffy's prior campaign manager and Rochester's Director of Fire Administration, Molly Clifford, regarding that matter. A criminal complaint for Aggravated Harassment 2nd in regard to the non-payment of the dirt digger's fee, and/or for an alleged threat, was filed on August 4th. Rochester Police Chief David Moore did not notify County Executive Maggie

ELECTION 2010
