HELLO MAGGIE, GOODBYE LOUISE

This year the U.S. Federal Court, pursuant to 10 year redistricting, created New York's new 25th Congressional District. That C.D. includes all of Monroe County except for the Towns of Hamlin, Mendon, Rush and Wheatland. Therefore, for the first time in recent memory there will be one Congressperson who will represent most of Monroe County. This year's election in the 25th will be a high profile, super bowl, political contest. Incumbent Congresswoman Louise Slaughter will be challenged by Monroe County Executive Maggie Brooks. The eyes of America will be on the fascinating election contest in the 25th C.D. this November.

Louise Slaughter has been a Congresswoman for 26 years. She has been an elected official for 36 years. She is a career politician. On April 8th, 2011, Louise said: "Republicans came to Washington to kill women". Then she likened all Republicans to "Nazi's". This in response to proposed budget cuts? Mean and Nasty! That's Louise. She tried to subvert democracy as the House Rules Committee Chairwoman by inventing the anti-American "deem and pass" for Obama Healthcare. Aggressive and Arrogant! That's Louise.

Louise Slaughter is an avowed radical-Liberal (The American Conservative Union gave her a 0 rating). She is a puppet of the National Unions and bizarrely obsessed with the failed and rejected concept of "High speed rail". During 2011, she missed more House votes than almost any of the 434 other Congresspeople. Unlike other Representatives, Louise is too arrogant and important to hold Local "Town Hall" meetings with her constituents.

Louise Slaughter will be electorally challenged this year. She has lost her politically Gerrymandered "ear muff" district (Rochester, Buffalo, and Niagara Falls). In Rochester, she should be weaker since she didn't support Bill Johnson in the Mayoral Special Election. Louise opposed Renaissance Square for petty reasons (not her idea). This cost Rochester many jobs and a very good federally funded revitalization project. For the last 10 years, Louise has concentrated her efforts on Buffalo and not Monroe County. She voted against her constituents interest by opposing N.A.F.T.A.

Senator Alesi Commits "CRIMINAL TRESPASS"

Then, He Sues!

Now His New Campaign Strategy Is To Be A Victim (Again!)

On January 19, 2008, State Senator James Alesi and a female friend approached the premises known as 15 Conover Crossing in the Town of Perinton. Said premises was private property owned by John C. Hecker, Jr. and Janet N. Hecker. It was purchased by them on October 25, 2007. It was not a construction "model". There were no signs indicating it was anything other than a private residence. Alesi tried the front door which was locked. Then, he went behind the house, pushed open the basement door, and entered. The Heckers' were not present. Thereafter, Alesi injured himself inside the house. Alesi was a trespasser. He was not an invitee or a licensee. The Monroe County Sheriff's Department police report indicates that Alesi was obviously illegally in the house. (See Penal Law section 140.15 and/or Penal Law section 140.10- Criminal Trespass 3rd

and/or Criminal Trespass 2nd) The Heckers', an elderly couple and Alesi's constituents, were given their options by the Sheriff's Department. The police recommended that they file criminal charges against Alesi. However, the Heckers' being nice and forgiving people, gave Alesi a break by not charging him with Criminal Trespass.

The Statute of Limitations for Criminal Trespass is 3 years. It is also 3 years for negligence. Therefore, on January 18, 2011, Alesi, knowing he was no longer effectively liable for his illegal action, sued Mr. & Mrs. Hecker in State Supreme Court for alleged negligence (Alesi vs. Hecker, et. al). Bizarrely, he claimed he was a “victim”? The action consisted of a six page Summons and Complaint. The lawsuit caused the Heckers' much undeserved humiliation, publicity, embarrassment, and pain. Alesi illegally entered a private house, injured himself, and his lawsuit attempted to blame the completely innocent homeowners for his illegal conduct? Alesi's ridiculous legal action became a National scandal (Fox News, etc.)! Local Republican Chairman, William Reilich, said he was “outraged” by the lawsuit. It was “unacceptable”. He said Alesi should “apologize”. County Executive Maggie Brooks severely criticized Alesi for his actions. Alesi was mocked and held up to ridicule for his bizarre, insulting, and unfair lawsuit.

Every year the New York State Conservative Party grades the individual New York State Senators on their votes on “ideological bills”. In 2011, 24 proposed laws which dealt with: taxes, spending, taxpayer funded abortions, curtailing anti-American funeral vicinity demonstrations, gun control, and other Conservative issues were used in the rating. There are currently 6 State Senators who represent part of Monroe County. Their 2011 Conservative ratings were as followed: Senator Gallivan 72%, Senator Maziarz 68%, Senator Nozzolio 72%, Senator Ranzenhofer 68%, and Senator Robach 72%. Alesi received a 2011 Conservative rating of 52%! His Conservative voting record was the lowest of the thirty-two Republican State Senators. Alesi failed our Conservative values test. Since the Con-

crat & Chronicle. She virtually writes her own news stories and editorials. The local Gannett paper is very biased, unfair, and dishonest. It will do “anything” in this year's Congressional campaign to elect Louise and defeat Maggie. The D&C has very unfairly attacked Maggie for the last 8 years by inventing irrelevant non “scandals”. The election this November in the 25th C.D. is a classic ideological political match up. Louise is an embarrassing, arrogant, nasty, Liberal extremist. She is a Nancy Pelosi Democrat. ELECTION 2011

Last year, we endorsed 114 well qualified candidates for public office. Our Party had 103 victorious candidates. We were the "Margin of Victory" in many key contests (Chili Supervisor, County Legislature, etc.). Our newly re-acquired ballot line, Row C, was strong and consistent. With 7, 398 enrolled Conservatives, one of our candidates (Justice Tom Moran) received 15, 894 votes (215% "Conservative" voter turnout on Row C). This with a 32% general voter turnout! Voters of all registrations liked our good candidates and our common sense Conservative philosophy. Election 2011 was a very good year for the Monroe County Conservative Party.
