HILLARY: A LIAR AND A NATIONAL SECURITY RISK!

Her dishonesty has recently been notorious and outrageous in regard to her private server non-government e-mail account which she established in 2009. Hillary, in early 2015, claimed that she had wiped clean her 32,000 "personal" e-mails on said server. Her employee recently took the 5th Amendment in regard to said incident.

Hillary's relevant e-mail lies are as follows: "I thought it would be easier to carry one device". False! A F.O.I. showed she had multiple electronic devices (IPAD, Blackberry, etc.). "The server contains personal communications from my husband". No! Bill Clinton has sent a total of 2 e-mails, both as President.

"I never had a subpoena". False. The Congressional Benghazi Committee (T. Gowdy) issued her a subpoena. "I did not e-mail any classified material". No! Her e-mail actions violated Federal Law (U.S. Code Title 18 Part I Chapter 37 § 798). She knew the information was classified based on her Secretary of State position and her experience. What she did was much worse than what was done by General David Petraeus. Hillary's private e-mail actions probably violated various Espionage Laws. Her destruction of 32,000 e-mails could be viewed as an anticipatory obstruction of justice.

Arrogance! Hillary believes she can lie with impunity! She thinks regulations and Laws are only for the little people. Hillary should be indicted! She compromised our National security. Hillary's private server dishonesty indicates that she should never be our President!

ELECTION 2015

With a few notable exceptions, this year's election, ELECTION 2015, is going to be rather boring. This is basically a result of the partial demise of the Monroe County Democratic Party. In my 36 years as Chairman of the Conservative Party, I have never seen the Democratic Party this weak. They have little money, a fractured organization and very poor candidates. In fact their political ally, the Democrat & Chronicle, in a July 31, 2015 article admitted that the Democrats this year has; "no stand out candidates". In Election 2015, the Democrats have only 59 endorsed candidates. Many of those are unqualified and were actually the 2nd or 3rd choice. In contrast, the Monroe County Conservative Party this year endorsed 116 very well qualified conservative oriented candidates.

The Democratic candidate for County Executive, the former Supervisor of the People's Republic of Brighton, was the Democrats' 4th choice as a County Executive candidate. She is a politician of the 80's and 90's. She is making bizarre, irrelevant statements in an attempt to try to get attention. The Republican-Conservative candidate for County Executive, Cheryl Dinolfo, is a superb administrator. As County Clerk she has saved the Monroe County taxpayers millions of dollars. Cheryl has stood up to 3 different Governors in order to protect

the citizens of Monroe County. She will be a great County Executive! District Attorney, Sandra Doorley, has two unique talents. She is an excellent trial lawyer and a very good administrator. Our residents are well served and protected by her effective professional prosecution of those who threaten our citizen's security.

The Monroe County Legislature has been controlled by Republican-Conservative Legislators for at least twelve years. They along with County Executive Brooks, have kept County taxes and spending low. The Legislature has shrunk the County work force. They have prioritized public safety and government efficiency. All 29 Legislative seats are up this year. It is very important for our community that a Republican-Conservative majority of the County Legislature be re-elected (see list on front page).

A tradition of the Monroe County Conservative Party, for the last 36 years was to support and help elect great Judicial Candidates. This year we will continue that history. Judy Sinclair is running for State Supreme Court. Judy who has been a lawyer for 24 years has probably successfully handled more trials (500+) than any other private attorney in Western New York. Judy has professionally disposed of over 15,000

other legal cases. The Monroe County Bar Association has the only Attorney Bar Poll to rate judicial candidates. Judy received a very high 91.3% favorable Bar rating (from 158 attorneys with "meaningful contact"). She is running a great campaign and she will be an excellent Judge. The other 3 Supreme Court candidates: Judge Doran (Administrative Judge 7th Judicial District), Judge Piampiano (County Court Judge), and Judge Taylor (Pittsford Town Court Judge), are very good Judges who will continue the Conservative Party's history of Judicial Excellence. They are firm, but fair Judges! James A. Vazzana, the managing partner of a large prestigious Monroe County law firm, will be a very good Family Court Judge.

Election 2015 should be a very good year for our conservatively endorsed candidates. This is partly due to the demise of the Monroe County Democratic Party (except in Irondequoit). Our candidates have the money and organization to win on November 3rd. However, the main reason that they will win on Election Day is that they are THE VERY BEST CANDIDATES! When our candidates win on November 3rd, with the help of the Conservative Party, this will greatly benefit the citizens of Monroe County.

WHO FOR PRESIDENT?

There are various political theories which will help determine who the New York State Conservative Party will endorse for U.S. President next year. The Buckley Rule is that we should endorse the most Conservative candidate who can win. A "viable" right wing candidate!
